
## AGM ENVIRONMENT REPORT 2022: CARBON FOOTPRINT REDUCTION



BRANCHES FACED DIFFICULTIES IN: COORDINATING THEIR WORK, SCALING UP PROJECTS SUCH AS THE INSTALLATION OF SOLAR PANELS WITH INADEQUATE FUNDS FOR TRANSITION; CHALLENGING POLICIES THAT AIM AT CARBON-CONSUMING GROWTH; &DDRESSING IGNORANCE, INERTIA AND INADEQUATE ENGAGEMENT.



BRANCHES ARE ADVOCATING SDGS THAT LINK WITH GREEN AIMS; BRANCHES ARE SUPPORTING INDIVIDUAL CARBON FOOTPRINT REDUCTIONS; BRANCHES FACE A TENSION BETWEEN ORGANISING IN-PERSON EVENTS AND REDUCING THEIR CARBON CONSUMPTION. SOME BRANCHES APPRECIATED THESE REMINDERS IN HELPING THEM DEVELOP GREEN POLICIES.
