#### Israel/Palestine

The situation in Israel/Palestine is terrible and fast getting worse. Many of those trying to help – including at least 11 staff members of UNWRA (the UN agency doing humanitarian work with the Palestinian refugees) in Gaza – have been killed in the last 2 weeks.
